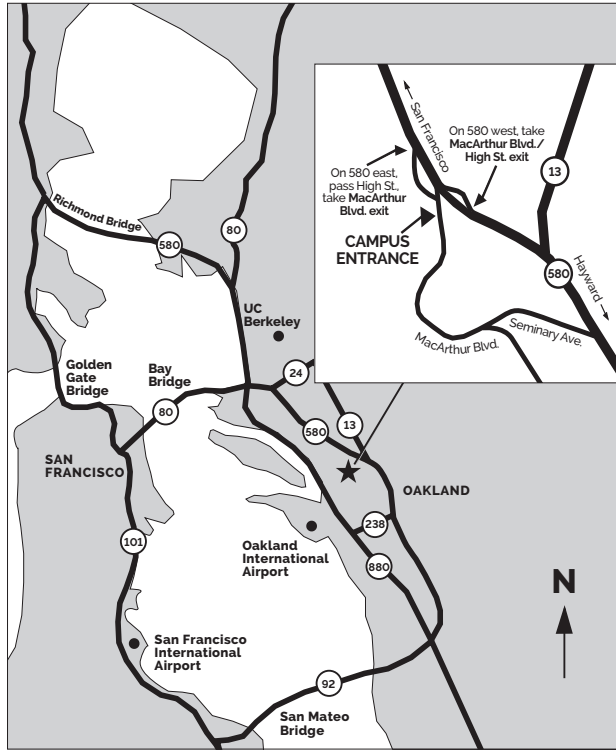

Northeastern's Oakland campus is located immediately off of Highway 580 in Oakland at the junction of 580 (MacArthur Freeway) and Highway 13 (Warren Freeway), approximately seven miles from the Bay Bridge. There are three MacArthur Blvd. exits from 580 east, so please follow the directions carefully.

Via 580 east (from points north and west): Take I-580 east toward Hayward/Stockton. Take the second MacArthur Blvd. exit (after High St.). Bear right onto MacArthur Blvd. The gate is immediately ahead on your left.

Via 580 west (from points south and east): Take I-580 west to the MacArthur/High St. exit (Exit 25) just after the junction with Highway 13. Turn left at the stop sign and proceed under the freeway overpass. Turn left at the light onto MacArthur Blvd. The gate is immediately ahead on your left.



Campus Parking

Guests must pick up a date-stamped parking pass at the security gate upon arrival, and may park in any parking area designated as Commuter or Guest. We also provide limited, specially designated parking areas for zero emission vehicles. Commuters, faculty, staff, and regular visitors must purchase a parking pass from the Department of Public Safety (DPS), located in the CPM Building, room 113.

Deliveries to Campus

Small packages should be delivered to the Mail and Copy Center in Rothwell Center. Large loading dock deliveries should be delivered to the Corporation Yard at the end of Pine Top Road. Maximum trailer length is 24 feet. Deliveries may not be left at the security gate.
